## NEW LASER RACKS 2007

As of April 30<sup>th</sup>, NOSA's new Laser (or equal size) rack storage system in place for 14 berths complete with 14 Laser dolly's designed for the use in the racks. NOSA's 4 Laser's will occupy 4 of the 14 berths closest to the water. 10 berths are available for members.

NOSA custom Laser dolly's **MUST** be used in the storage berths. First time laser storage fee in the NEW storage rack system is \$257 (\$57/year plus a one time only \$200 deposit for the Laser dolly). The dolly deposit will be returned to the member when the Laser Moorage Contract is terminated). Members wishing to purchase a Laser dolly out right can do so (if available)
