

End of year Regatta Call for Volunteers

The NOSA regatta will be held on **June 12-13th** this year. It is intended to be a fun weekend for everyone and a wrap up to the racing season. In order to keep the event fun for everyone a number of volunteers are needed to run the event.

Below is a list of positions with a short description of the duties for the position. If you are willing to fill one of these positions please contact Stuart Parker at parkerfc@telus.net or at 250-803-0181. Your assistance in making this a great wrap up to the year will be truly appreciated by everyone. **Note that volunteering for one of these positions qualifies for a “NOSA Bucks” \$50 Rebate.**

1. Registration
 - Register entrants on Friday evening and Saturday morning prior to the races.
 - Collect entry fees.
 - Notify food volunteers of the number of meals required.
2. Food – breakfast and lunch
 - Organize breakfast and lunch on the club deck for Saturday and Sunday. Includes setup and cleanup afterwards. Breakfast can be bagels and muffins with coffee and juice. Lunches can be sandwiches or pizza with juice and pop.
3. Food – Saturday dinner
 - Organize dinner on the club deck after racing on Saturday night, including setup and cleanup afterwards. Dinner can be steaks/burgers/roast and salads, buns, etc.
4. Communication
 - Send out fliers/email/etc. to all local clubs at the beginning of August.
 - Send out race results to all participating clubs.
 - Prepare “thank-you’s” for all volunteers.
5. Race Committee
 - Organize and run the races over the 2 days (similar to Thursday night duties).
 - Document the results.
6. Race Management & Safety
 - Organize the crash boat crews.
 - Setup and take down course markers.
 - Assist photographers in taking pictures of event.
7. Harbour Master
 - Organize stowage for visiting boats and crews.
 - Organize space for visiting crew who wish to camp overnight.
8. Prizes & trophies
 - Organize prize categories (best dressed crew, slowest boat, etc.) purchase prizes.
 - Meet with Race Committee to identify trophy winners.
 - Get plaques for trophies engraved.
